2. Finance Report

The Glasgow Area Partnership Grant has been received and the club will contribute £320 which means a wheel lock and trailer insurance can be covered. We are projecting over £300 surplus.

3. Development Strategy

4. Grant Application Award

An order has been placed with Collars for of a set of oars which should be ready in April. Ashton Marine Services have supplied a quote for a road trailer, which incorporates a launch trailer. CMT have indicated where we may store the trailer. Means of fundraising for ancillary equipment and rules and guidance for use to be agreed.

5. Skiff Building Update

The build is on schedule and the boat will be turned this week so that work on the inside can commence. Clyde Maritime Trust hope that the impetus of this project will encourage members to be involved in future CMT projects. There is interest in this from members but many are available only outside working hours.

6. Barge Update

Electricity will be installed at the beginning of February. PAT testing arrangements to be checked.
