2. Finance Report

Current surplus is £1200. After materials for Lady Danger's refurbishment we are projecting an end of year surplus of around £1100. The Development Fund (members' voluntary contributions) stands at £550 and we carried forward £600 forward from last year, which means member subs are more or less covering annual running costs.

3. Fleet Maintenance

Thanks was expressed to the volunteers for the successful refurbishment of Gobhancroit. The three skiff covers should be ready within a week.

Maintenance work on Lady Danger will start in January and should take 3 weeks.

Kelvin Kelpie's cox seat will be repaired as soon as the weather permits.

Those members interested in attending regattas are encouraged to source suppliers and specifications for racing oars. Peter Armstrong has trimmed one of the existing oars and other volunteers are invited to work on lightening the weight on the remainder of the set.

4. Equipment and Clubhouse

A few volunteers will be required to assist with attaching the hooks which will secure the new skiff covers. The system for preparing the skiffs for un/covering will be developed and skippers will be trained on this process.

The clubhouse is in much better order and another tidy will be required in the New Year.

The far side of the barge still needs to be painted and sealant applied to the exterior window surrounds to prevent water ingress.

Thanks was expressed to Jim Dick for his attention on keeping the pontoon clean.

The damaged floats will be addressed when work on Lady Danger begins.

5. Year of Coastal Waters 2020

SCRA has been in touch regarding GCRC taking part in this round Scotland event. A group of members interested in taking part are encouraged to go ahead and organise this, whilst keeping the committee informed, and are invited to join the committee. The club is awaiting further information on this event.
